

Warehouse Inventory Intern

The primary duties of this internship are collection for the transition from Manager Plus to Kinetic. The intern team will be working within a group to help tie company part numbers, vendor part numbers, and manufacturer part numbers together. They will also work to update bins with the new Biewer part numbers.

This is a paid internship opportunity (\$16/hour) that will run from mid-May/June through August. Interns must be able to work 40 hours per week. Candidates are not required to be currently pursuing a secondary education.
