Accountabilities:

Primary responsibilities will include:

- Operates and maintains equipment and machinery.
- Matches barcodes to appropriate units.
- Identifies the appropriate barcode tags and placards to use and ensures accuracy.
- Uses tagging/staple gun to put customer required stickers on individual pieces of a unit, ensuring each piece has a tag before being sent out.
- Identifies different sizes of plywood and lumber appropriately.
- Ensures the proper bag size and wrapping for the lumber material.
- Operates bander, pneumatic stapling gun, and hammer stapler safely.
- Separates lathe sticks from the material using a bar/tool, and places lathe sticks in the box making sure they are neatly stacked.

- instructions.
